## Nuclear Weapons and European Security – a good match?

*Seminar by SIPRI and the Swedish Defence Research Agency (FOI)

Nuclear weapons have been part of the European security structure for more than 60 years, including both strategic nuclear weapons and tactical nuclear weapons. 20 years after the Cold War has ended, with a different understanding of the security threats to Europe as well as different security mechanisms with new NATO members and a suspended arms control regime, it is certainly time for a renewed discussion on the role nuclear weapons play or should play in Europe.
