Note: The figures in this table were calculated on the basis of NATO statistics on the distribution of total military expenditure by category. The shares for personnel and equipment are applied to the figures for total military expenditure in constant 1998 US dollars, as presented in table 6A.3. Prior to 2001, France was not included in the NATO statistics on military expenditure by category. In table 6B.2, SIPRI therefore provides its own calculation of French expenditure on military equipment, as presented in its official defence budget. The revision of figures in constant dollars from previous SIPRI Yearbooks is due almost entirely to revisions in the economic statistics (consumer prices indices), as provided by the IMF, and not to changes in the original figures for military expenditure and the shares thereof.

of finished equipment, infrastructure and technical and industrial investment, and investment subsidies). These figures are not comparable to the equipment expenditure as defined by NATO and presented in table 6B.1.
